- **Basic Search - Keyword Search** – default is AND (looks for all the terms and phrases)

Search # 1:

- Limit your search – select fulltext
- Search: Caledonia AND “native people”
- Select only Canadian magazines and/or newspapers
- Sort
- Narrow Results by Subject
- Select an article
- Place article in folder or email to yourself
